E. STUDENT ACCEPTABLE USE POLICY (AUP) FOR CKS TECHNOLOGY

We are called to always bring a spirit of gratitude for generous donations from Parents Club and our school and parish families that make it possible to engage in 21st Century learning and to grow more digitally literate in an ever-evolving world. We are called as well to faithfully strive to be good stewards of the resources that we enjoy.

1. General settings on the technology must remain the same. Do not change backgrounds, move icons, change the names of the icons, delete icons.
2. Passwords will be assigned and monitored by the school and are never to be changed.
3. You may only access your own account. Students are never to share their passwords or accounts with others. A teacher will never give permission for you to open another student's account.
4. Students must follow safe web browsing techniques and practice safe and ethical digital citizenship.
5. All devices must be handled properly and respectfully.
6. Please conserve and be judicious in your use of paper. Always know which printer you are using before you launch a print job.
7. READ all message boxes while on the Internet. Never randomly click yes/no/download, etc. Pay attention and know what you're clicking. When in doubt, always ask an adult.
8. Permission to open personal email accounts on school computers will only be given by the teacher.
9. The technology at CKS is for educational purposes only. Games will never be accessed on school technology unless they are for educational purposes. If an activity does not relate to the curriculum, you may not open it. When in doubt, ask the teacher.
10. Chat rooms, blogs, and social networking sites are forbidden on school computers.
11. Every incident involving device damage will be evaluated on an individual basis.
